

Year 2 – Ustadah Madiha

Maths

Numbers 0–100 and different ways of representing, comparing, and ordering these. They will start with recognise tens and ones, begin to use place value chart to partition tens and ones, while identifying numbers in words and numerals. Later, they will be able to write numbers to 100 in an expanded form. Pupils will start to add and subtract 2-digit numbers, while looking at number bonds. They will later explore the properties of various 2-D and 3-D shapes.

English



Children will be reading this gorgeous picture book from Leigh Hodgkinson which is a beautiful book about celebrating difference and accepting ourselves and others for who they are. Children will learn to write character descriptions, instructions, diary entry and a story with character focus.

Science – Animals including Humans

Children are introduced to the three basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air). They will apply this knowledge, to suggest ways to look after pets. This topic ends with children looking at healthy lifestyles, including the importance of exercise, healthy eating and hygiene.



Geography – The School Setting

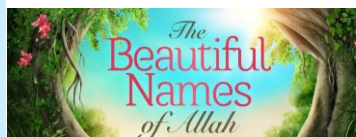
Pupils will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the human and physical geography of the school, its grounds and the local area. Pupil will learn to name, locate and describe key landmarks and features in the local area, use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key features of the local area and conduct a school survey about local transport.



Islamic Studies

This lesson explores some of the names of Allah. Pupil will analyse the five names of Allah; learn the translations and deeper meanings and they will also construct beliefs about Allah from these names.

Quran & Arabic

Quran: pupils will start with a general revision of all memorised surahs from previous year, they will also start the memorisation of surah Al-Bayyinah. While for Arabic the children will be revising the letter formation, such as shapes of the letters, short and long vowels.



DT – A Balanced diet

Pupils will gain an understanding on the principles of healthy and varied diet, while discovering there are hidden sugars in food and drinks. The students will have the opportunity in designing and making their own healthy wraps.



PSHE-

PSHE this term will be linking with DT expanding on the importance of a healthy diet. Gaining an awareness of what a healthy diet looks like. Based on what they have learnt they design and create their own healthy sandwich.



Computing-SMART Rules-

Pupils will revise what the SMART rules stand for and what they mean. They will begin linking these to their own online behaviours. Pupils will explore and create their newspaper article. By the end of the topic pupil will edit their newspaper article, looking at fonts, font sizes, font colours and border colours.
