

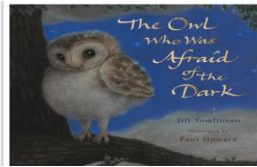
## Year 2 – Ustaadha Madiha

Maths

**Addition and subtraction** - adding and subtracting smaller 2-digit numbers to and from larger ones and doubling and halving 2-digit numbers. Later in the half term they will focus on **shapes**. Grasping an understanding on the different shapes and the properties each shape has.

English **The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark**

Pupils will write a fact file about owls using information gathered from the text and by drawing on what they learnt about owls during the unit.

Science – Animals and their Habitat

Children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive while applying this in a range of contexts.

History – Great Fire of London and The Great Pague

Pupils will begin to sequence people, events, objects, and photos and fit them onto a pre-prepared timeline with a scale, using different sources of evidence, ask questions and produce answers to a few historical enquiries and recognise why people did things, why events happened and what happened as a result, identifying basic causes and effects.

Islamic Studies

In Islamic studies we will be looking at deeds of a person and what consequences deeds have on the day of judgement. We will also explore the theme of good manners and the importance of having friends. Pupil will learn what adab mean and how that applies with regards to the learning environment. Children will learn about Bismillah and occasions when to recite it.

Quran & Arabic

Pupils will learn to identify and recognize the short phrases with the short vowels, Sukoon and Shaddah. Develop reading skills to allow them read unfamiliar words.

Art - Cubism- Picasso

They will be focusing on an artist's style of work and will be building their skill to create different shades/tones. Towards the end of the unit, they will create a paper collage based on Picasso's artwork.

Computing- Creating media  
Digital photography

Pupils will understand and recognise that different devices can be used to capture, edit, and improve photos which will enable them to recognise that some photos have been edited to be made better.

PSHE – Identity and differences

Identify special things about them that make them who they are, describe similarities and differences between themselves and others and the things they have in common, recognise how they are all equal despite their differences, identify the different groups they belong to (e.g., friends, class, year group, faith), and identify the different roles within them like friends, pupil, leader etc.
