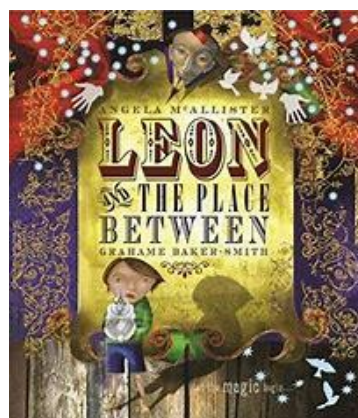

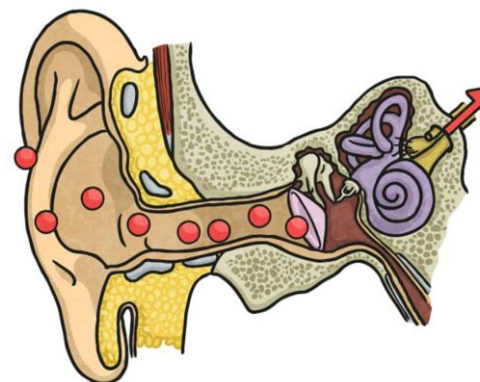
Literacy – Text: Leon and the Place Between

In this unit, the children will be asking questions and exploring ideas about different characters and settings. Children will revisit previous learning in grammar and punctuation and build on it through writing a fictional narrative. This will present an opportunity to further develop their writing vocabulary and literary skills.



Science – Sound

This term, children will identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating. They will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear, and that sound waves are slower than light waves. Children will also find patterns between the pitch of sounds and features of the object/speed of vibration and find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it. Children will recognise that sounds get fainter as distance from source increases.

Children will be exploring the concept of virtue and looking at certain actions and their virtues. They will also learn the importance of salah and how to prepare for salah. Children will learn the importance of good character and how it actualises in daily life.

Computing – Creating Media:

Audio production



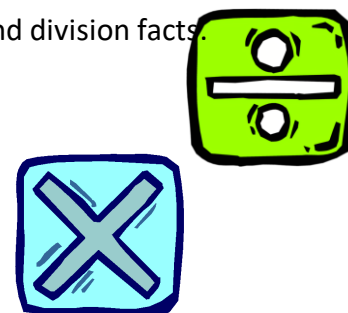
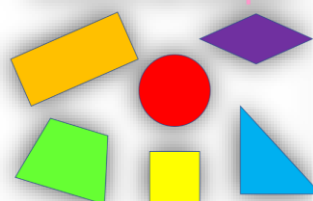
In this unit, children will identify the input device (microphone) and output devices (speaker or headphones) required to work with sound digitally. They will discuss the ownership of digital audio and the copyright implications of duplicating the work of others. Children will use Audacity to produce a podcast, which will include editing their work, adding multiple tracks, and opening and saving the audio files.

Numeracy

Area and multiplication & division

Our mathematicians will begin with learning about working out the area of a shape. They will follow on by learning multiplication and division. Children will study 3, 6, 9- and 12-times table. They will use division to check their multiplication sums and vice versa and learn key multiplication and division facts.

Areas of 2D Shapes



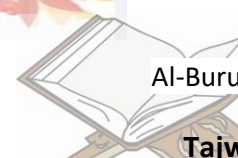
Reading

In this unit, the children will be asking questions and developing understanding of inference. They will use drama to explore characters and suspense. They will develop editing and proof-reading skills. They will plan, edit and write a new episode of the fantasy story they have studied.

History – Local History

Town Hall, Luton

This term, children will develop chronological knowledge of the history of Luton, identifying trends and contrasts over time. They will learn where people in the past migrated from using a range of sources to learn about the past. Children will also explore the car industry in Luton and why it was important historically.

PSHE – Making decisions About Money

Year 4 will understand making choices about money is important. Children will understand how people make different spending decisions based on their budget, values and needs. They will also understand that how people spend money can have positive or negative effects on others - e.g. charities, single use plastics. We will link this unit to Islam, about how we can be rewarded if money is spent correctly.



D&T – Pavilions

In this unit, children will create a range of different shaped frame structures. They will design a pavilion structure using square or rectangular base. Children will create a model pavilion joining a range of structural beams to create strong and stable structures and add cladding to the pavilion structure.



Physical Education – Football

Children will focus on team sports and games to build team spirit and understanding of one another better. They will continue to develop their skills of endurance, speed and agility and work on warm up and cool down habits.
